Left brain logic

Literacy and language, exploration and STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) and sustainability are taught by our dedicated Educators in small groups using active strategies such as demonstrating, open questioning, shared thinking and problem solving.

Right brain creativity

Music, dramatic play and art is practised daily through play-based learning and uninterrupted play. Our campuses have an abundance of stimulating resources to encourage your child's creativity.

Health & wellbeing

Growing bodies and minds need physical activity, nutrition and safe sleep practices to thrive. Our expert in-house Health Team includes Occupational Therapists, Speech Pathologists and Dietitians to care for your child's total wellbeing.
