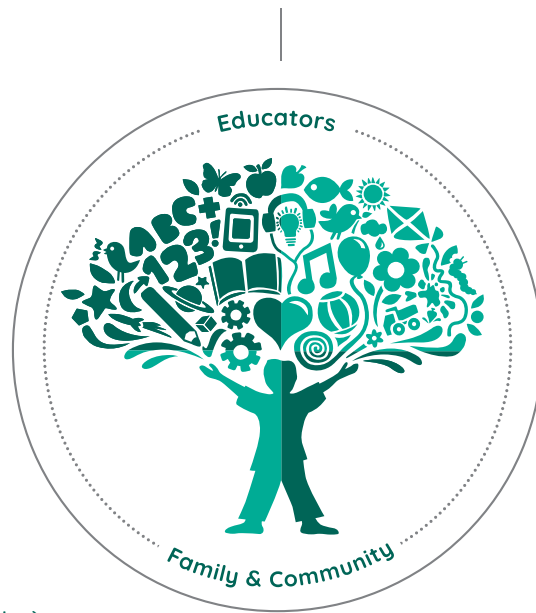

Transitioning between age groups?

We understand that children learn in different ways and at their own pace. Not all children in the same room move at the same time - they move when they are developmentally ready. Our teams monitor every child's development and progress and communicate with families about how they can support their child's progress when transitioning into a new room.

How many curriculum levels are there at Only About Children?

At Only About Children, there are 3 age-based curriculum levels, as we care for children from 6 weeks to 6 years. Our Toddler Curriculum is specially designed for curious toddlers and to help prepare them for the next stage. From 3-6 years, your child will really benefit from our 2 year Preschool/Kindergarten Curriculum, which has a strong focus on school readiness.

With our Preschool/Kindergarten Curriculum, your child will enjoy the continuity of care they received in our Nursery and Toddler rooms, while the benefits of a structured 9am-3pm School Readiness Program provide opportunities for social development and learning outcomes during the day. The flexibility of longer hours also helps to meet the needs of busy families.
